AMENDMENTS AGREED TO

DISASTER MANAGEMENT BILL
[B 21—2002]

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1. On page 6, in line 24, to omit “63. Special events”.

CLAUSE 1

1. On page 10, from line 4, to omit the definition of “special event”.

CLAUSE 4

1. On page 12, from line 1, to omit paragraph *(c)* and to substitute:
 - (c)* members of municipal councils, selected by the South African Local Government Association.

CLAUSE 5

1. On page 12, in line 26, to omit paragraph *(d)* and to substitute:
 - (d)* municipal officials selected by the South African Local Government Association;

CLAUSE 17

1. On page 22, from line 34, to omit paragraph *(b)* and to substitute:
 - (b)* classifying parts of the database as restricted areas in consultation with the Minister, and limiting access to those parts to persons authorised by the Minister.

CLAUSE 28

1. On page 30, after line 57, to add:
 - (3) (a)* A provincial disaster management framework, or any amendment thereto, must be published in the relevant provincial gazette.
 - (b)* Before establishing or amending a provincial disaster management framework, particulars of the proposed framework or amendment must be published in the relevant provincial gazette for public comment.

1. On page 38, after line 27, to insert:

1. Dat op bladsy 13, in reël 26, paragraaf (d) geskrap en vervang word deur:
 - (d) munisipale amptenare wat uitgesoek word deur die “South African Local Government Association”;

KLOUSULE 17

1. Dat op bladsy 23, vanaf reël 36, paragraaf (b) geskrap en vervang word deur:
 - (b) sekere gedeeltes van die databasis in oorleg met die Minister as beperkte gebiede te klassifiseer en toegang tot daardie gedeeltes te beperk tot persone wat deur die Minister gemagtig word nie.

KLOUSULE 28

1. Dat op bladsy 31, na reël 58, bygevoeg word:
 - (3) (a) ’n Provinsiale rampbestuursraamwerk, of ’n wysiging daarvan, moet in die betrokke provinsiale koerant gepubliseer word.
 - (b) Voordat ’n provinsiale rampbestuursraamwerk ingestel of gewysig word, moet besonderhede van die voorgestelde raamwerk of wysiging vir openbare kommentaar in die betrokke provinsiale koerant gepubliseer word.

KLOUSULE 37

1. Dat op bladsy 39, na reël 27, ingevoeg word:

- (xi) institutions that can provide scientific and technological advice or support to disaster management;

CLAUSE 38

1. On page 38, in line 36, after “must” to insert:
 , within the applicable provincial disaster management framework—

CLAUSE 51

1. On page 50, after line 45, to insert:
 - (ii) organised labour in the municipality;
2. On page 50, after line 51, to insert:
 - (ix) institutions of higher education;
 - (x) institutions that can provide scientific and technological advice or support to disaster management;

CLAUSE 53

1. On page 52, in line 33, after “must” to insert:
 , within the applicable municipal disaster management framework—

CLAUSE 56

1. On page 56, in line 39, after “to” to insert “response efforts and”.
2. On page 56, after line 42, to insert:
 - (3) The Minister may, in the national disaster management framework, prescribe a percentage of the budget, or any aspect of a budget, of a provincial organ of state or a municipal organ of state, as the case may be, as a threshold for accessing additional funding from the national government for response efforts.
