**G20 DISASTER RISK REDUCTION WORKING GROUP MEETING**



The Director-General of the Department of Traditional Affairs, Mr Mashwahle Diphofa chaired the last day of the four-day programme of the G20 Disaster Risk Reduction Working Group (DRR WG) Meeting happening in eThekweni at the Chief Albert Luthuli International Convention Centre (ICC). Today's deliberations were grounded on emerging best practices in the implementation of the "Build Back Better" approach in South Africa.

The meeting also explored concrete actions that contribute to the realisation of Priority 5: Disaster Recovery, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction through instruments such as the Recovery Readiness Assessment Framework.

Furthermore, on Priority 6: Ecosystems-Based Approaches for DRR/Nature-Based Solutions (NbS), delegates discussed a compendium of case studies and analysis of policies that incentivize investment in NbS, such as subsidies, tax benefits, and climate finance integration, which encourage both public and private sector engagement.
