The eThekwini Metro has endured some of the most devastating disaster phenomena recently, compounded by the changes in global weather patterns. Presentations covering the compendium of risk transfer solutions that can support most at risk communities to access much-needed cash liquidity quickly in both pre- and post-disaster scenarios informed the rich discussions.





Another topic of interest anchored on Priority 2: Global Coverage of Early Warning Systems, was informed by an input paper on the progress, barriers, and enabling mechanisms to deliver Cellular Broadcasting as a scalable solution for last mile delivery of Early Warning.
